- 2) At meeting time (7:00 PM the 1st Tuesday each month) open ZOOM.
- 3) Click the "Join" icon & the "Join Meeting" dialog displays.
- 4) Enter the Meeting ID: 915-464-442 & click "Join."
- 5) Enter the password (*if required*) noting case sensitivity for characters. The "*Waiting for the host to start this meeting*" dialog displays.
- 6) Then the system displays "Waiting" until you are accepted into the meeting.
