### PRESENTATION

#### **Fox Hunting**

Charles (KN4KWA) spoke about recent jamming that has showed up on 40 Meters. He played portions of two *Ham Radio Crash Course* YouTube videos, "*The Cuban Jamming Crisis On 40 Meters Ham Radio*" and "*Explaining the Cuba Radio Jamming with W7HU*", which included history of the problem and a demonstration of how to use web-enabled SDR stations to do radio
