ARRL PUBLISHES FIELD-DAY SCORES

On page 72 of the December issue of QST you can find the 2023 Field Day score we achieved, listed in ranking order. We are in Category 3A (3 transmitters using non-commercial power). Our 1,155 contacts, when augmented with 1,250 bonus points, gave us a total of 4,610 points. This score put W4YK in

among the 6 NC and 4 SC clubs in this category.

Notice the impact of our bonus points on the total score. They, like the 2x multiplier for CW contacts, significantly increased our score.
